

STEPS TO HOMEOWNERSHIP

The following are part of the Homebuying process. Before you watch Module 1 put these 19 steps into what you think is the best order. Keep in mind that there is not an absolute correct order — while some steps do need to go in a specific order (for example: I have to find a home before I can buy a home), other steps have a bit more flexibility in the order they can be done. Once complete, return to the video for Module 1 and we'll review the steps in detail with your Homewise Trainer.

Buyer secures homeowners insurance	Attend a homebuyer education class
Closing at the Title company	Find a home and sign a purchase contract
Apply for the mortgage loan and Homewise financial assistance	Meet with a Home Purchase Advisor to develop action plan and prequalification
Work with a broker and shop for a home	Create budget to save for down payment
Closing date is set	Buyer previews closing documents
Work on action plan and fix any credit problems	Loan package prepared for underwriting; credit report and appraisal ordered by lender
Buyer's final walkthrough inspection	Seller builds home or prepares property for sale and makes any agreed-on repairs
Contract a home inspector	, -
Buyer prepares money needed for closing	Underwriter reviews loan application and issues final approval
Closing documents are assembled	Reach 'Buyer Ready' status

^{*}This activity assumes you are buying an existing home, not a home that has to be built, as that process would be a little different.
